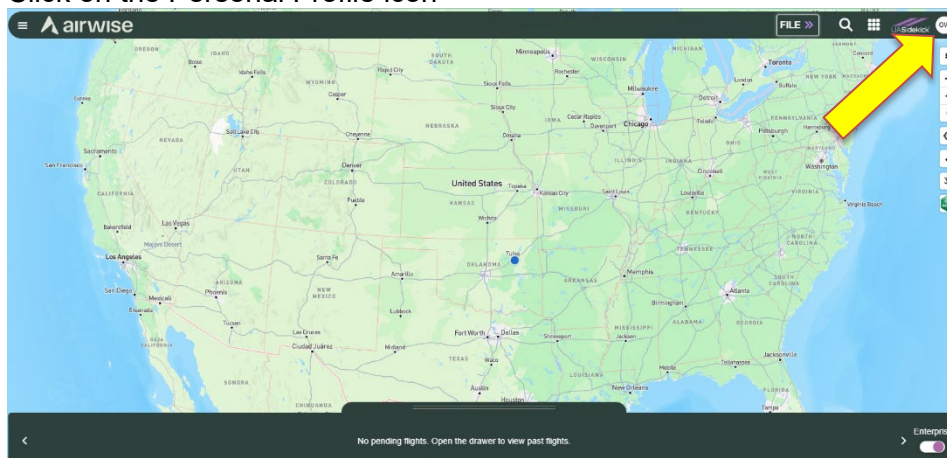
Pin Sign In

Airwise Sidekick saves you from having to key in your password every time you need to 'Sign In' by providing a Pin Sign In option.

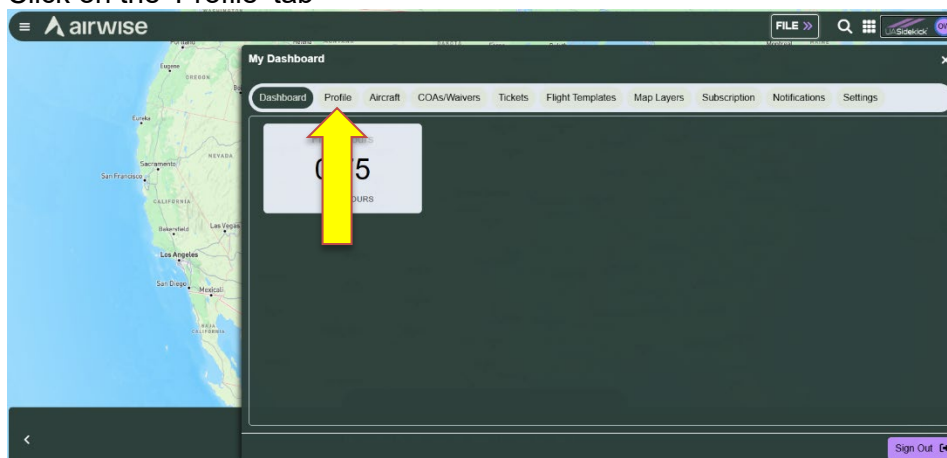
When set, you will only be asked to enter your pin to Sign into your account. You must 'Sign In' once with your username and password before PIN 'Sign In' is available.

To login using a PIN code:

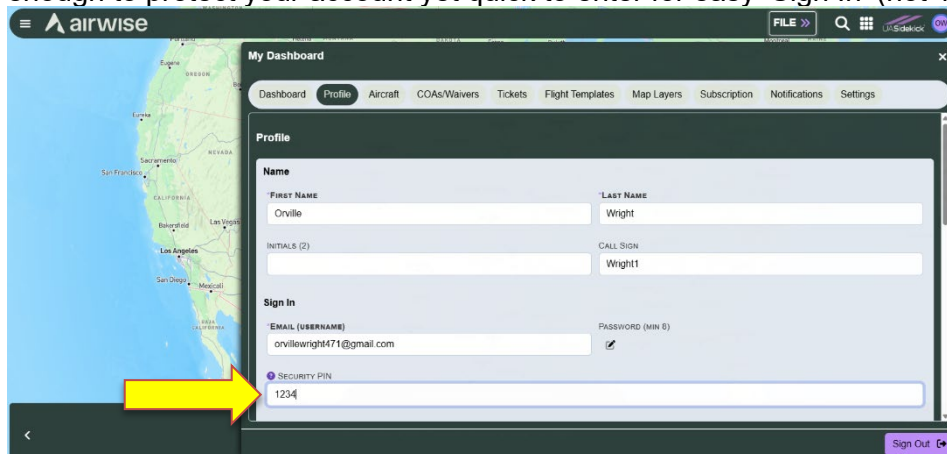
1. Click on the Personal Profile icon



2. Click on the 'Profile' tab



3. Enter a 'Security PIN' code. There are no specific requirements. It should be secure enough to protect your account yet quick to enter for easy 'Sign In' (not 1234).



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4. After entering your Security PIN, scroll down and click on 'Save'

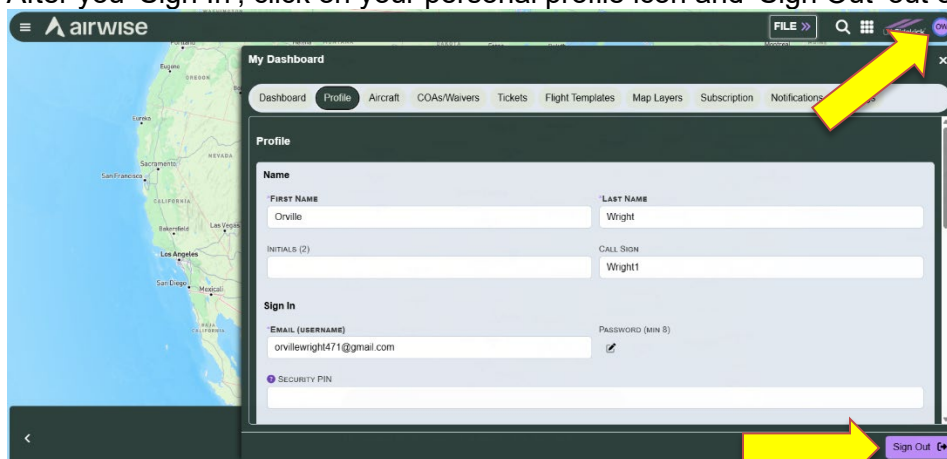

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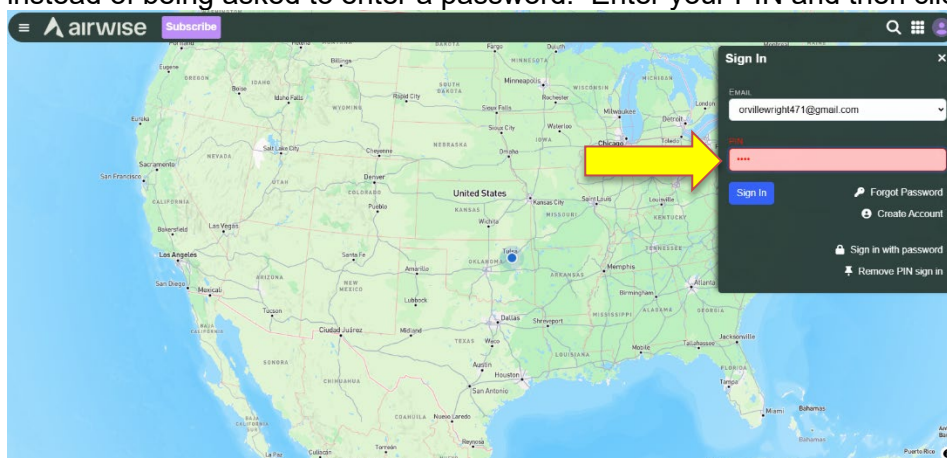

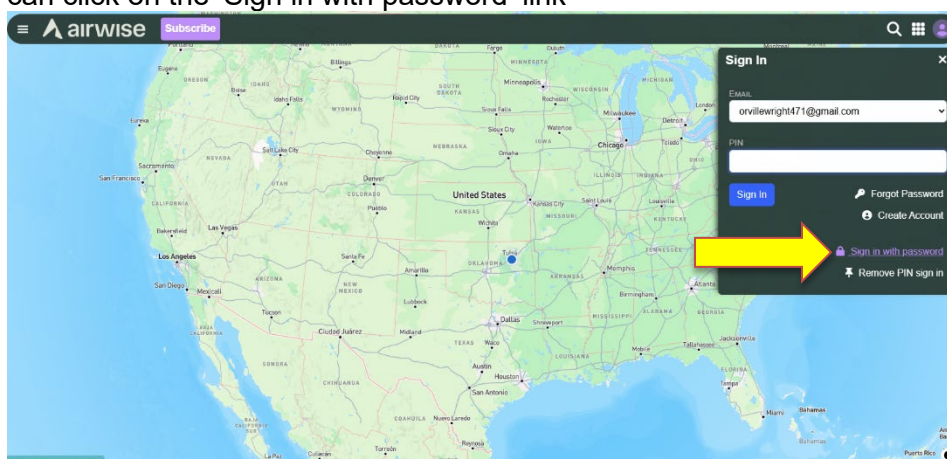
7. After you 'Sign In', click on your personal profile icon and 'Sign Out' out one more time.



8. Now when you go to 'Sign In' you should be presented with the option to enter your PIN instead of being asked to enter a password. Enter your PIN and then click on 'Sign In'.



9. If you ever decide you would rather enter your password or if you forget your PIN you can click on the 'Sign in with password' link



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10. To remove your PIN, go to the Profile tab of your personal Dashboard, select your PIN code and delete it.

12. Make sure the system notifies you that your profile has been updated and then 'Sign Out'.

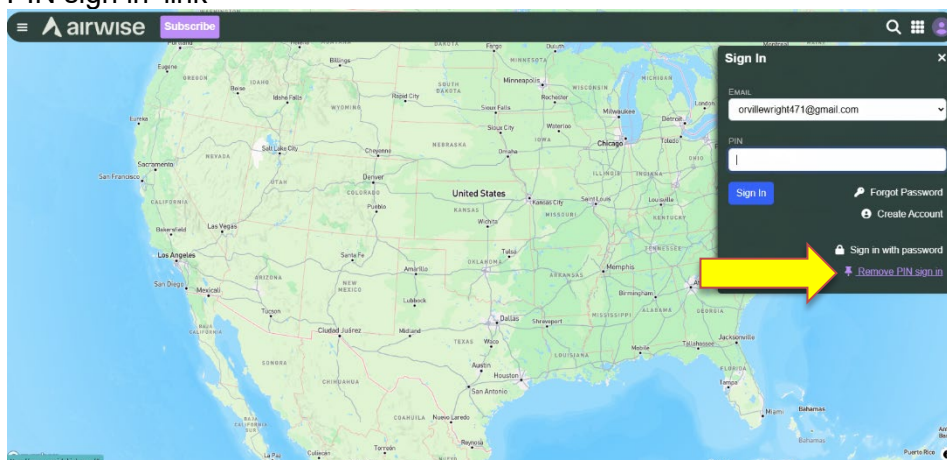
